
PIPELINE UPDATE

- "White-tailed Kites have not nested successfully at Rio Bosque since 2011. Ind-November, a 2nd kite joined the single bird that had been present all summer and fall. With serious courtship behavior already evident, we have high hopes for 2015.
- " On a sad note, the collared peccapy javelina that first appeared at the park in early June was killed in a collision with a truck along the Riverside Canal levee roaid early November
- "With water limited in summer, the 3 Wood Duck nest boxes at Rio Bosque have netwerd nesting ducks, but Western ScreechOwls roost in them occasionally. This fall and winter, screechowls have occupied all 3 boxes at one time or another.
